### ADMISSION OF STUDENTS FROM ABROAD TO UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-2026

#### THOSE WHO CAN APPLY

a) Individuals who are in their final year of secondary education or have graduated may apply under the following conditions:

1. Foreign nationals (who have registered at secondary education institutions in Türkiye prior to the 2022-2023 academic year, [with the exception of those studying in embassy schools, international private educational institutions listed in the MOBIS system, and individuals brought to Türkiye under projects conducted by the Ministry of National Education])
2. Individuals who were born as Turkish citizens and have subsequently lost their citizenship by obtaining permission to renounce citizenship from the Ministry of Interior as well as those who can prove that they have a blue card, which is given to those who lost their Turkish citizenship upon request (on condition that those studying in secondary education institutions in Türkiye registered before the 2022-2023 academic year). (Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901 states that "(1) A child born to a Turkish citizen mother or father in wedlock, whether in Türkiye or abroad, is a Turkish citizen." It is useful for candidates who will apply for the quotas from abroad to review the Turkish Citizenship Law.)
3. Individuals who have acquired Turkish citizenship after previously holding foreign nationality / those with dual citizenship in this situation (provided that they registered at secondary education institutions in Türkiye prior to the 2022-2023 academic year.)
4. Turkish citizens who have completed their entire secondary education in a foreign country other than the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) (including those who have completed their entire secondary education in Turkish schools abroad that are recognized by the Ministry of National Education, excluding the TRNC.)
5. Those who are citizens of the TRNC and reside in the TRNC and have completed their secondary education in the TRNC and have GCE AL exam results, and those who have/will have GCE AL exam results after registering and receiving education in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005 and 2010, or those who are citizens of the TRNC and have completed their entire secondary education in a foreign country and have TR-YÖS results.

#### THOSE WHO CAN NOT APPLY

b) The following candidates are not eligible to apply:

1. Turkish citizens who have completed their entire secondary education in Türkiye or the TRNC,
2. Those who are TRNC citizens (except those who have completed their entire secondary education in TRNC high schools and have GCE AL exam results, those who have/will have GCE AL exam results by enrolling and receiving education in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005 and 2010, or those who are TRNC citizens and have completed their entire secondary education in a foreign country and have TR-YÖS results),
3. Dual citizens whose first nationality is Turkish by birth, as defined in subparagraph 2 of article a (except those who completed their entire secondary education in a foreign country other than TRNC or those who completed their entire secondary education in Turkish schools in a foreign country other than TRNC),
4. Dual citizens, one of whose nationality is TRNC (excluding those who completed their entire secondary education in TRNC high schools and have GCE AL exam results, those who registered and received education in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005 and 2010 and have/will have GCE AL exam results, or those who are TRNC citizens and completed their entire secondary education in a foreign country and have TR-YÖS results),
5. Turkish citizens or dual nationals whose first nationality at birth is Turkish as defined in subparagraph 2 of Article a, and who study at schools affiliated with embassies in Türkiye or at foreign high schools in Türkiye,
6. Citizens of the TRNC and individuals who have lost their Turkish citizenship / blue card holders, as well as foreign nationals who will enroll in secondary education institutions in Türkiye starting from the 2022-2023 academic year (excluding those studying in embassy schools and international private educational institutions recognized by the MOBIS system and foreign individuals brought to Türkiye under projects conducted by the Ministry of National Education).

#### DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR APPLICATION

- Application Form
- A Turkish copy of Exam Result Document, certified by a Notary or a Turkish Embassy abroad
- A copy of the high school diploma or the document showing that the candidate is in the final year approved by a Notary or Turkish Embassies abroad (translated into Turkish),
- An official transcript showing the courses and grades taken by the candidate in high school, approved by the high school principal, and a Turkish copy of the transcript approved by a Notary or Turkish Embassies abroad
- A photocopy of the passport and a certified Turkish translation approved by a Notary or Turkish Embassy abroad,

- Entry and exit dates of students who are Turkish citizens or dual nationals (including those with a blue card) and studying high school abroad to the country where the high school is located (can be obtained via e-government or from the Ministry of Interior)
- For Turkish citizens or dual nationals (including those holding a blue card) and studying high school abroad, a Turkish copy of the document approved by a Notary or Turkish Embassy showing the mode of education (e.g., formal, distance, online, etc.) of the high school they studied abroad,
- Two passport-sized photographs,
- Bank receipt confirming the application fee of 900 TL deposited to the Çankaya University bank account:

The validity period for exams considered as University Entrance Exams (e.g., SAT) is two (2) years, whereas exams classified as High School Graduation Exams (e.g., Abitur, International Baccalaureate, GCE, Tawjihi) are valid indefinitely.

**In accordance with Article 5 of the “Memorandum of Understanding on Cooperation in the Field of Higher Education between the Council of Higher Education of the Republic of Türkiye and the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan,” only the exam results administered by the State Examination Center of the Republic of Azerbaijan are accepted for the admission of students with Azerbaijani nationality. Applications based on other criteria will not be considered.**

#### APPLICATIONS

The application deadline for our university is **August 5, 2025**. Applications must be submitted either by post or in person to the Student Affairs Directorate of our university. Applicants may apply to multiple programs. Applications submitted online are invalid.

#### EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

Applications will be evaluated, and placements will be made by Çankaya University. The university reserves the right to fill or not fill the available quotas. Meeting the application requirements does not guarantee admission. A list, prepared by a commission designated by Çankaya University, containing the rankings within the program and the quota, will be submitted to the Rectorate for approval.

#### APPLICATION RESULTS

Application results will be announced on the university's website. Accepted candidates will receive an acceptance letter upon payment of the tuition fee for the Fall semester of the 2025-2026 academic year into the university's account. With this letter, candidates must obtain a “student visa” from the Turkish Embassy in their home country (or the nearest one). Registration for those granted final admission will take place on **August 26-27, 2025**. Candidates will be informed about the required documents through their acceptance letters. These documents will also be published on the university's website.

#### LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

While the majority of our programs are conducted in English, some departments offer instruction in Turkish.

Students enrolling in programs where the language of instruction is English are required to take the English Proficiency Exam administered by the University's English Preparatory Unit. Students who do not pass this exam must attend a one-year preparatory program. Upon successful completion, they can commence their studies in their departments. Documents of students holding scores from TOEFL or other similar internationally recognized language exams will be evaluated by the Department of Foreign Languages.

Students enrolling in programs where the language of instruction is Turkish must possess a Certificate of Turkish Proficiency issued by official institutions and organizations of the Republic of Türkiye, including universities. Students without this certificate are granted one year to obtain it. If a student fails to present this document at the end of the given period, her/his enrolment at the university will be terminated.

#### TUITION FEES

Education at Çankaya University is subject to a fee. Students are required to pay half of the tuition fee at the time of registration at the beginning of the academic year, and the other half at the time of registration at the beginning of the second semester.
