ADMISSION OF STUDENTS FROM ABROAD TO UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027

THOSE WHO CAN APPLY

a) Individuals who are in their final year of secondary education or have graduated may apply under the following conditions:

1. Foreign nationals (provided that they have not studied at or graduated from secondary education institutions in Türkiye, excluding foreign nationals who have completed their entire high school education at embassy schools or international private educational institutions registered in the MOBIS system, and foreign nationals who have come to Türkiye within the scope of projects carried out by the Ministry of National Education or the Council of Higher Education).
2. Those who were Turkish citizens by birth but lost their Turkish citizenship after obtaining permission to renounce it from the Ministry of Interior, and those who can document that they hold a Blue Card issued upon request to persons who have lost Turkish citizenship (provided that they have not studied at or graduated from secondary education (high school) institutions in Türkiye or the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC)). Applicants who will apply under international student admission quotas are advised to review Article 7 of Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901.
3. Foreign nationals who subsequently acquired Turkish citizenship, and dual nationals in the same situation (provided that they have not studied at or graduated from secondary education (high school) institutions in Türkiye or the TRNC).
4. Turkish citizens who have completed their entire secondary education (high school) in a country other than the TRNC, including those who have completed their entire secondary education (high school) at Turkish schools established by the Ministry of National Education in such countries.
5. Citizens of the TRNC who have not studied at or graduated from high schools in Türkiye or from high schools in the TRNC that implement the Turkish curriculum, and who meet the requirements specified in the application and admission guidelines approved by the Council of Higher Education, based on GCE AL, TR-YÖS, or examinations accepted by higher education institutions.

THOSE WHO CAN NOT APPLY

b) The following candidates are not eligible to apply:

1. Turkish citizens who have completed their entire secondary education (high school) in Türkiye or the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC).
2. Those who are TRNC citizens (except those who have completed their entire secondary education in TRNC high schools and have GCE AL exam results, those who have/will have GCE AL exam results by enrolling and receiving education in colleges and high schools).
3. Dual citizens whose first nationality by birth is Turkish, as defined in Article 7 of Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901 (excluding those who meet the conditions specified in Clause (a)(4)).
4. Turkish citizens, or dual nationals whose original nationality by birth was Turkish as defined in Article 7 of Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901, who are studying at embassy schools in Türkiye or at foreign high schools located in Türkiye.
5. a) Citizens of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC), and individuals who have renounced Turkish citizenship or hold a Blue Card, who are studying at or have graduated from secondary education (high school) institutions in Türkiye or the TRNC.
b) Foreign nationals who are studying at or have graduated from secondary education (high school) institutions in Türkiye, excluding those studying at or graduating from embassy schools, international private educational institutions registered in the MOBIS system, and foreign nationals admitted to Türkiye within the framework of projects carried out by the Ministry of National Education.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR APPLICATION

- Application Form
- A Turkish copy of Exam Result Document, certified by a Notary or a Turkish Embassy abroad
- A copy of the high school diploma or the document showing that the candidate is in the final year approved by a Notary or Turkish Embassies abroad (translated into Turkish),
- An official transcript showing the courses and grades taken by the candidate in high school, approved by the high school principal, and a Turkish copy of the transcript approved by a Notary or Turkish Embassies abroad
- A photocopy of the passport and a certified Turkish translation approved by a Notary or Turkish Embassy abroad,
- Entry and exit dates of students who are Turkish citizens or dual nationals (including those with a blue card) and studying high school abroad to the country where the high school is located (can be obtained via e-government or from the Ministry of Interior)
- For Turkish citizens or dual nationals (including those holding a blue card) and studying high school abroad, a Turkish copy of the document approved by a Notary or Turkish Embassy showing the mode of education (e.g., formal, distance, online, etc.) of the high school they studied abroad,
- Two passport-sized photographs,

The validity period for exams considered as University Entrance Exams (e.g., SAT) is two (2) years, whereas exams classified as High School Graduation Exams (e.g., Abitur, International Baccalaureate, GCE, Tawjihi) are valid indefinitely.

In accordance with Article 5 of the “Memorandum of Understanding on Cooperation in the Field of Higher Education between the Council of Higher Education of the Republic of Türkiye and the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan,” only the exam results administered by the State Examination Center of the Republic of Azerbaijan are accepted for the admission of students with Azerbaijani nationality. Applications based on other criteria will not be considered.

APPLICATIONS

The application deadline for our university is **August 7, 2026**. Applications must be submitted either by post or in person to the Student Affairs Directorate of our university. Applicants may apply to multiple programs. Applications submitted online are invalid.

EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

Applications will be evaluated, and placements will be made by Çankaya University. The university reserves the right to fill or not fill the available quotas. Meeting the application requirements does not guarantee admission. A list, prepared by a commission designated by Çankaya University, containing the rankings within the program and the quota, will be submitted to the Rectorate for approval.

APPLICATION RESULTS

Application results will be announced on the university's website. Accepted candidates will receive an acceptance letter upon payment of the tuition fee for the Fall semester of the 2025-2026 academic year into the university's account. With this letter, candidates must obtain a “student visa” from the Turkish Embassy in their home country (or the nearest one). Registration for those granted final admission will take place on **August 26-27, 2026**. Candidates will be informed about the required documents through their acceptance letters. These documents will also be published on the university's website.

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

While the majority of our programs are conducted in English, some departments offer instruction in Turkish.

Students enrolling in programs where the language of instruction is English are required to take the English Proficiency Exam administered by the University's English Preparatory Unit. Students who do not pass this exam must attend a one-year preparatory program. Upon successful completion, they can commence their studies in their departments. Documents of students holding scores from TOEFL or other similar internationally recognized language exams will be evaluated by the Department of Foreign Languages.

Students enrolling in programs where the language of instruction is Turkish must possess a Certificate of Turkish Proficiency issued by official institutions and organizations of the Republic of Türkiye, including universities. Students without this certificate are granted one year to obtain it. If a student fails to present this document at the end of the given period, her/his enrolment at the university will be terminated.

TUITION FEES

Education at Çankaya University is subject to a fee. Students are required to pay half of the tuition fee at the time of registration at the beginning of the academic year, and the other half at the time of registration at the beginning of the second semester.
